- **Date:** Saturday, March 27, 2010
- **Time:** 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- **Location:** Galpin Honda: Showroom
11151 Laurel Canyon Blvd., Mission Hills, CA 91340
- **Stakeholder Verification Method:** Documentation
- **Minimum Voting Age:** 18
- **Number of Positions up for election:** 14
- **Max number of positions a candidate may seek:** no more than one Board seat
- **Vote-By-Mail Procedures**
 - Only offered to voters who physically are unable to go to the polls due to a disability
 - Must affirm under penalty of perjury that they meet those requirements
 - All VBM Applications must be requested by phone. Voters must call (213) 978-8050 to receive a VBM Application. For Los Angeles City Residents in need of TTY assistance, dial 311, or for those outside of Los Angeles, please dial (213) 485-2121
- **Key dates that you should know:**
 - Vote-By-Mail (VBM) Period: December 28, 2009 to March 17, 2010
 - Candidate Filing Period: December 28, 2009 to January 26, 2010
 - Write-in Candidate Filing Period: January 27, 2010 to February 25, 2010
 - **Candidate Withdrawal shall coincide with respective filing deadline**
 - Candidate Statement Submission Deadline: February 25, 2010
 - VBM Return Deadline: March 24, 2010

Reminders

- Due to the fiscal crisis, the City Clerk will not be providing mailers and will not be involved in the election outreach process. This also means that we will not be facilitating or participating in any candidate forums.
- Ballots will not be counted at the Polling Place. All ballots will be counted back at Piper Technical Center which is the headquarters of the City Clerk's Election Division. Ballots will be tallied the next City of LA business day and official results will be available within seven (7) City of LA business days after the election.
