Those that can qualify for this seat: Any stakeholder who is 18 years of age or older.
- d. Discussion and possible action to fill Organizational Stakeholder / Employee Stakeholder Seat **x1** (2020).
Those that can qualify for this seat: Any stakeholder 18 years of age or older who works in a business within the MHNC boundaries or participates in a religious institution, educational institution, community organization, non-profit organization, neighborhood association, school/parent group, faith-based group, senior group, youth group, arts association, service organization, boys or girls club, cultural group, or environmental group within the NC boundaries.
- e. Discussion and possible action to fill Residential Homeowner Stakeholder Seat **x1** (2020).
Those that can qualify for this seat: Any stakeholder who owns a home or condo within the MHNC boundaries and is 18 years of age or older.

- f. Discussion and possible action to fill Residential Homeowner Stakeholder Seat **x1** (2023).
Those that can qualify for this seat: Any stakeholder who owns a home or condo within the MHNC boundaries and is 18 years of age or older.
- g. Discussion and possible action to fill Residential Renter Stakeholder Seat **x1** (2023).
Those that can qualify for this seat: Any stakeholder who rents within the MHNC boundaries and is 18 years of age or older.
- h. Discussion and possible action to appoint Youth Seat **x1** (2023).
Those that can qualify for this seat: Any stakeholder who lives, works, owns property or declare a stake in the neighborhood as a community interest stakeholder who is between the ages of 16 and 25.

Please note that under the Brown Act, the Board is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board meeting. Public comment is limited to 2 minutes per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of the Board.
